Dear friends in Christ: Greetings to you from Kumasi, Ghana!

Christmas program:

It was a delight to see the children sing and dance to the well-rehearsed program of songs. My wife worked tirelessly through the month of December, with the children coming most evenings to practice their parts and prepare for our Christmas program. Some of the songs we choose were with a strong and simple gospel message. We did this purposely and strategically to use the holidays as opportunity to share the glorious gospel message with the children, and through them to others. You can find a couple of videos of our program posted on my Facebook page, if you are interested to see more. We also managed to give all the church and visiting children a small gift package with Christmas treats. The attendance was very encouraging, with some visitors and some home from school for the Christmas holidays.

New Emmaus Book Room:

It has been on my heart for quite some time to set up a book room for our Emmaus ministry. The room we use for the teen class opens onto the street in front of our house, and I have added some shelving to display the courses and several books and gospel materials. We are hoping to also make bibles available as the Lord supplies these to us. We often receive requests for bibles, but currently have run out of copies to share with those who are in need. We especially would like to give bibles to the children who have been coming regularly, so that we can encourage them to read along with the church reading program through the Old Testament, as well as our Matthew Sunday afternoon reading program with the Sunday school children.

We hope the Emmaus book room will provide more exposure for the bible courses and materials we have available, and draw more into the study of God's word, or even to attend our church meetings.

Old Testament Studies:

We continue to work our way through reading and teaching in the Old Testament. The elders have provided messages to outline the book of Exodus, and I am due to introduce Leviticus in the new year. I spoke with the teen class yesterday, providing some teaching from Leviticus on holiness, challenging them to be holy so that they can walk with God. We also illustrated how the Lord Jesus can make us holy through His sacrifice upon the cross. I will present the teen class with a test on Genesis next week where they will be required to write the name of each old testament book with its corresponding number of chapters.

e-Teams 2020:

We are planning another e-Teams outreach in 2020 from May 15th to Jun 1st. We have included a poster with this email so that you can help advertise this mission trip among those you fellowship with. We look forward to how the Lord will assemble a team to spread the gospel and encourage the saints here in Ghana.

During this past month I took time to update our website. I have wanted to do this for a long time but needed better software to accomplish the task. I found a program on my computer which served the purpose and I was able to redesign the entire website adding some new features and offering some resources that may prove interesting and helpful.
